- We ramped up COVID-19 by first testing our employees and making testing available to you at NO Cost
- To date, we have tested over 300 community members and the numbers will continue to grow
- We will be taking our testing efforts on the road by providing Mobile Testing to communities who may not have the ability to Drive Up

We are not just providing a COVID-19 test rather, each patient is seen by a certified medical provider to discuss and assess your healthcare needs utilizing Telehealth services. These services are personalized with you in mind to avoid the confusion of receiving results and knowing exactly what to do once your results are received. We will be introducing the next phase of testing which will include antibody testing. (We have the ability to provide antibody testing today.)

Just this week, we opened Dental services to clients following Governor Edward's recent order. These services will ensure that our community does not suffer and require emergency room assistance thus, reducing the load of our area hospitals.

We will continue to provide access to COVID-19 testing for as long as this invisible threat is present in our community.

For the past 6 weeks we have ramped up Telemedicine care to ensure your safety as well as our Healthcare Heroes. We have continued access to care to all primary care and specialty care services throughout this pandemic.

Join me in celebrating our Community's Healthcare Heroes who will go to the extreme to protect your health. I am proud to work alongside such amazing professionals.
